This Addendum forms a part of the Contract Documents and Drawings, and modifies the original bidding documents dated May 2009.

The following items of the Contract Documents are modified as part of this Addendum:

Deletion of State of Georgia Utility Contractor License Requirement

It is not a requirement that the bidder hold a valid State of Georgia Utility Contractor License. All references that the bidder must hold a valid State of Georgia Utility Contractor License shall be deleted from the bid documents.

Bidding Requirements:

- **Section 00030-2 (Advertisement for Bids), 4th Paragraph**
 - Replace existing paragraph with the following paragraph (the phrase “**and be labeled with the BIDDER'S State of Georgia Utility Contractor License Number.**” has been deleted):

Each bid must be submitted in a SEALED ENVELOPE, addressed to the OWNER. Each sealed envelope containing a Bid must be plainly marked on the outside as, "Bid for **Lakeshore Drive Roadway Improvements** for City of Jefferson". If bid is forwarded by mail, the sealed envelope containing the Bid must be enclosed in a separate mailing envelope to the attention of the OWNER at the address previously given.

- Section 00100-1 (Instructions to Bidders), Last Paragraph
 - Replace existing paragraph with the following (the phrase “**the BIDDER'S State of Georgia Utility Contractor License Number.**” has been deleted):

All blank spaces for unit prices, lump sum prices, and alternate bid price schedules must be filled in, in ink or typewritten, in both words and figures (in case of discrepancy, unit prices shown in words will govern), and the foregoing items must be fully completed and executed when submitted. Bids shall have original signatures, and must be submitted in a SEALED ENVELOPE bearing on the outside, the name and address of the bidder and name of the project for which the Bid is submitted. The OWNER has the right to reject any bid that does not contain the above information.

- Section 00100-3 (Instructions to Bidders), #10, Qualifications of Bidder
 - Delete 2nd paragraph “The bidder must hold a valid State of Georgia Utility Contractor License.”
