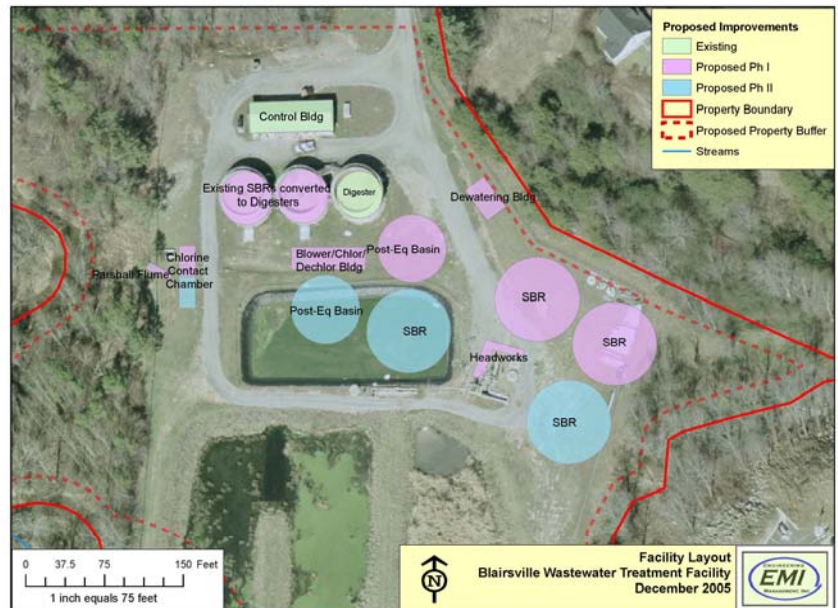

City of Blairsville

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The City of Blairsville is the sole provider of sanitary sewer services in Union County, Georgia. As the County Seat and hub of commercial development for Union County, Blairsville is faced with the need to expand its existing wastewater treatment facility. To guide the City through this very important project, Blairsville contracted with Engineering Management Inc. to plan, organize, design and permit the project. Concurrently, EMI is also assisting the City with operations of the existing facility.

The project is being funded by a loan/grant from USDA-Rural Development. Components of the facility include SBR technology, disinfection by chlorination and on-site sludge management. Construction of the expansion will take place while maintaining current service to existing customers.

When completed, this project will more than double the capacity of the wastewater treatment facility; and, provide the City of Blairsville and Union County the ability to accommodate future residential, industrial and commercial growth.
