EMI's staff of certified water and wastewater treatment plant operators is heavily involved in the operations of several facilities. In addition, EMI represents these entities in meetings, inspections and compliance issues with EPD.

Charlie Mountain. Operation of .050 MGD groundwater treatment facility including chemical addition, pumping and equipment maintenance, process control sampling and analysis of C12, pH, and alkalinity. EMI completes and submits to EPD required monthly operating reports as well as monthly bacteriological sampling and analysis a well as all other water analyses required under the SDWA.

Cove Crest. Operation of .050 MGD groundwater treatment facility including chemical addition, pumping and equipment maintenance, process control sampling and analysis of C12, pH, and alkalinity. EMI completes and submits to EPD required monthly operating reports as well as monthly bacteriological sampling and analysis a well as all other water analyses required under the SDWA.

Habersham County Board of Education. Operation of a 0.18 MGD activated sludge wastewater treatment plant. EMI provides all services of operations including equipment maintenance, process control and permit sampling and analysis, completion of monthly operating reports, and all laboratory analysis required by EPD.

Waterfalls Resort. Operation of .020 MGD groundwater treatment facility including chemical addition, pumping and equipment maintenance, process control sampling and analysis of C12, pH, and alkalinity. EMI completes and submits to EPD required monthly operating reports as well as monthly bacteriological sampling and analysis a well as all other water analyses required under the SDWA.
