The Town of Maysville, Georgia, is ensuring adequate water capacity and pressures by embarking on a project for the construction of a new 500,000 gallon elevated water tank. The project is being constructed by Caldwell Tanks, Inc. from Newnan, Ga. Construction costs are estimated at \$713,000. The project is being funded by a \$300,000 grant from the Appalachian Regional Commission and a low interest loan from the Georgia Environmental Facilities Authority. The Georgia Mountains RDC assisted the Town with the ARC grant application and USDA-Rural Development is administering the ARC funds. Engineering Management, Inc. provided funding procurement assistance and engineering design services for the project. Construction is scheduled for completion in September 2007.

A groundbreaking ceremony was recently held in December 2006.
