The Town of Braselton's Northeast Relief Sewer Project was collaboration between the Town of Braselton, City of Oakwood, Georgia Environmental Finance Authority (GEFA) and the Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC). Planning for the project began in 2012, and many changes to the project evolved over time.

Unprecedented growth in the northeast section of Braselton dictated the need to upgrade and existing 10' sewer outfall line serving both residential and commercial customers. Moreover, commercial growth in the northernmost section of the service area necessitated extension of the sewer system. In addition, the City of Oakwood was experiencing growth in their southern service area and had a major shortfall in wastewater treatment capacity. The two communities partnered in the final project development which allowed Oakwood to purchase capacity in the Braselton Water Pollution Control facility. Oakwood initiated a project to transfer wastewater from their southern service area to Braselton's proposed NE Relief Sewer project.

The final project included over 8,000 linear feet of 12" to 36" gravity sewer line, including a large bore under I-85 and SR 124, a 6 MGD wastewater pumping facility, and 2,200 linear feet of 14" force main. The project solved the Town of Braselton's overstressed existing outfall line, allowed the City of Oakwood to solve its shortfall of treatment capacity, and expanded the Braselton Sewer system. The project also resulted in the creation of 190 permanent employment positons and \$2.5 million in private capital investment as of November, 2017.
