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In the years prior to 2014 the Jackson County Water and Sewerage Authority (JCWSA) had challenges filling the elevated storage tank in Talmo, Georgia from the main portion of the JCWSA distribution system. JCWSA owned property located at the intersection of North Jackson Loop and Old Gainesville Highway which was the site of an abandoned water booster pump station. In late 2014 the Authority decided to proceed with the replacement of the abandoned booster pump station and hired EMI to provide design and bid phase services.

JCWSA required the construction of the new Talmo Booster Pump Station to be completed by mid-2015. EMI was issued a notice to proceed with design phase services in November 2014 and worked diligently to complete design and advertise the project for bids by early January 2015. Bids were received in February 2015 and construction began in March 2015. After a four-month construction contract time the project was completed in July 2015 and placed into service.
