Principals of Engineering Management Inc. have had a working relationship with Lincoln County for over twenty years. Initial assignments with Lincoln County included developing a Water System Master Plan and a Capital Improvements Plan. Planning and design services for the water system have included over 15 miles of water mains, development of 4 groundwater wells, a pressurized water filtration system and elevated storage facilities. Funding sources have included 3 Community Development Block Grants and 4 USDA Loan and Grant Programs. The Lincoln County water system has grown from under 100 customers to over 2000 in the past twenty years.

Services related to the wastewater system have resulted the construction of over 3.6 miles of gravity sewer lines, 8 miles of forcemains, and 5 lift stations.

Special services provided to Lincoln County have also included procurement of well drilling services, wellhead protection plans, property and water right negotiation, assistance with Service Delivery negotiations, assistance with Economic Development project and funding, development plan reviews, preparation of water system audits and Consumer Confidence Reports.
