City of Auburn Cabot's Drive Roadway Improvements

The City of Auburn is soliciting proposals from qualified construction firms for the full depth reclamation and asphalt overlay on a portion of Cabot's Drive.

The project consists of, but is not limited to the following major elements:

Full Depth Reclamation (FDR) of approximately 1,044 L.F. of existing roadway plus the cul-de-sac with a 40-foot pavement radius, reshape the low point area so water will drain to the existing concrete flumes, and asphalt overlay of the rehabilitated area with 2-inches of 12.5 mm Superpave.

Time of completion for all work associated with this project shall be thirty (30) consecutive calendar days from the date of a written "Notice to Proceed" from OWNER.
