Sealed bids will be received by the City of Woodbury, Georgia (OWNER), for furnishing all materials, labor, tools, equipment, and any other miscellaneous items necessary for the construction of Water Treatment Plant Improvements in Woodbury, Georgia.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held at the Woodbury Water Plant, 503 Lake Meriwether Road, Woodbury, Georgia 30293 at 10:30 a.m. local time on June 19, 2013. Representatives of OWNER and ENGINEER will be present to discuss the Project. Bidders are encouraged to attend and participate in the Conference. ENGINEER will transmit to all prospective Bidders of record such Addenda as ENGINEER considers necessary in response to questions arising at the Conference. Oral statements may not be relied upon and will not be binding or legally effective.

Bids will be received at Woodbury City Hall, 30 Durand Street, P. O. Box 297, Woodbury, GA 30293 until 2:00 p.m. on July 9, 2013. Any bid received after said time and date of bid opening will not be considered by OWNER. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at this time and location. All bids will be evaluated by OWNER and the project will be awarded, if it is awarded, within sixty (60) days of the bid opening. If a bidder is not selected within sixty (60) days of the bid opening, any bidder that is determined by the OWNER to be unlikely of being selected for contract award shall be released from their bid.

The award of this bid proposal, if awarded, shall be based on several criteria, including prices bid, experience in the work proposed, and references. Refer to Article 19 of Section 00200 for criteria and award method.

The Project consists of, but is not limited to the following major elements:

Upgrades and improvements to the existing water plant and raw water pump station. Major components will include a two-story building addition to accommodate new chemical feed systems and storage, concrete restoration of existing flocculation and sedimentation basins, construction of a new concrete flocculation basin, replacement of valves and actuators in existing pipe gallery, construction of a new office in existing building, new backwash ponds, generators, electrical, painting, site grading and drainage improvements, piping, etc.

Time of completion for all work associated with this project shall be three hundred sixty-five (365) consecutive calendar days from the date of a written "Notice to Proceed" from OWNER.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish OWNER with Insurance, Workman's Compensation Insurance, and Performance and Payment Bonds* in the amount of one-hundred percent (100%) of the total bid.

Each bid must be submitted in a SEALED ENVELOPE, addressed to the OWNER. Each sealed envelope containing a Bid must be plainly marked on the outside as, "Contract No. 1 – Water Treatment Plant Improvements for the City of Woodbury, Georgia" **and be labeled with the BIDDER'S State of Georgia Utility Contractor License Number.** If bid is forwarded by mail, the sealed envelope containing the Bid must be enclosed in a separate mailing envelope to the attention of the OWNER at the address previously given, and plainly marked on the outside with the notation "BID ENCLOSED".

All Bids must be made out on the bid form of the type bound in the Contract Documents, in accordance with the instructions in the Information for Bidders. No interlineation, additions, or deletions shall be made in the proposal form by the BIDDER.

Any and all Bids received without the aforementioned qualification criteria enclosed, will be returned to the BIDDER.

CONTRACTORS and SUBCONTRACTORS bidding on this Project will be required to comply with all Federal, State, and local laws.

OWNER reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all Bids, to evaluate Bids, and to accept any Bid which in its opinion may be in the best interest of the OWNER. No Bid will be rejected without just cause.

Successful Bidder will be required to perform WORK as the Prime Contractor. WORK performed by Prime Contractor shall be at a minimum 30% of the contract value.

No BIDDER may withdraw his bid within the time limit specified in the Instruction to Bidders (Section 00100).

The City has acquired all necessary State and Federal permits in connection with this project. The City has acquired all of the easements and rights of way in connection with this project.

* Surety companies executing Bonds must appear on the Treasury Department's most current list (Circular 570 as amended) and be authorized to transact business in the State of Georgia. For Performance Bonds less than \$300,000 an irrevocable Letter of Credit from a bank as defined in O.C.G.A. Code Section 7-1-4 may be submitted in lieu of a bond. In lieu of a Payment Bond, a Cashier's Check, Certified Check, or Cash may be submitted in an amount not less than the total amount payable by the terms of the CONTRACT.
